at NETHERURD

COME AND BE PART OF SOMETHING SPECIAL IN JULY 2010!

Join 1,000 Scottish Guides at Netherurd, the Scottish Training & Activity Centre in Peeblesshire for the Scottish Centenary Camp. Come with Guides from your own unit, district, division or County or come on your own and make lots of new friends.

You will sleep in a tent and will be allocated to one of the 20 sub camps each named after an international mountain. If you come as part of a group your own Guiders will be on the sub camp with you. Each sub camp will be staffed by experienced Guiders with the relevant camp and first aid qualifications. Your own Guiders don't need a camp licence to bring you to this camp. The minimum age is 10 and no camping experience is necessary.

The **COST** is £200 which includes site fees, food, activities, camp t-shirt and badge and transport from a designated point in your County. A **non returnable deposit of £50** must be paid with the application form. The **balance of £150** must be paid by 31st March 2010. Cheques should be made payable to "Girlguiding Scotland".

There will be an exciting and varied programme of activities with something for everyone:- you can choose from abseiling, climbing, water sports, art, music, dance, drama, creative crafts, glamorama, traditional camp activities, backwoods cookery, pioneering, community action, media reporting and much, much more; find out about international Guiding in the Global Development Village; enjoy fun and friendship at the camp fire, disco and ceilidh; have a fun day out or simply spend time relaxing with your friends.

There will be indoor accommodation for Guides who cannot sleep in a tent and a dedicated team of trained Guiders to provide support for Guides with additional needs.

Safety is one of our top priorities. All adventurous activities will be supervised by qualified staff. Girlguiding operates a Safe From Harm policy. All leaders and instructors with unsupervised access to the Guides will have completed a volunteer registration process and an enhanced Disclosure.
