GUIDER APPLICATION**

COME AND BE PART OF SOMETHING SPECIAL IN JULY 2010!

We aim to give 1,000 Scottish Guides and 100 Senior Section a once in a lifetime experience at *Caledonia 2010*, to be held at Netherurd, the Scottish Training & Activity Centre in Peebleshire. To do this we need enthusiastic and dedicated Guiders. Bring your Guides, come with a group from your District, Division or County or apply as camp staff. You do not need a Camp Licence to bring Guides and you do not need to complete an A/A or A/J form.

There will be 20 sub camps for Guides and their leaders, Senior Section and Camp Staff camps, each named after an international mountain. We already have volunteers from around Scotland to provide a core team of 5 Guiders to run each sub camp. If you would like to be with a particular sub camp team please indicate this on your application form and we will try to accommodate your request. Group Leaders will be on a sub camp with their Guides. All other Guiders will be on the Camp Staff sub camp.

All Guiders will have a specific role at camp or will be given a rota with a variety of jobs/activities throughout the camp. Team leaders are in place but we have plenty roles to be filled. Some require a particular skill or qualification but most just require enthusiasm, commitment and a sense of humour. **Choose from the following:-**

Activities - join one of the 5 Activity Teams:-

- **Adventurous** - abseiling, climbing, water sports, ski-ing, pony trekking, cycling etc.
- **Creativity & Performing Arts** - Crafts, music, drama, dance, glamorama and much more
- **Community Action** - working with local charities to raise awareness & learn new skills
- **Global Development** - games & activities on an International Theme
- **Traditional Camp Skills** - Backwoods cookery, incident hikes, games, pioneering
- **Catering Team** - large team needed for "cafeteria" style catering for the whole camp

Central First Aid / Additional Needs

Main Events Team - Opening & Closing, camp wide game, ceilidh, disco, campfire etc.

Admin Team - registrations, office admin, collating risk assessments/activity reports

PR / Marketing / Shop - Photographers, media reporters, camp shop

Crèche - open for Guiders' children (9 and under) during Activity Sessions

Leaders' Coffee shop - a place for Guiders to drop in and socialise

Site Services / security - toilets & showers, rubbish/recycling, car park, gate security etc.

The **COST** is £100 which includes site fees, food, camp t-shirt and badge and transport from a designated point in your County. A **non returnable deposit of £50** must be paid with the application form. The **balance of £50** must be paid by **31st March 2010**. Cheques should be made payable to "Girlguiding Scotland". To verify that applicants are active members of Girlguiding and have been Disclosed and to help allocate Guiders to the most appropriate roles we request a reference from your County Commissioner.

Applications will be acknowledged by email where an email address is provided. All further information, forms etc. will be sent by email for you to print unless paper copies are specifically requested. If coming as part of a group all information will be emailed to the group leader only.
