COME AND BE PART OF SOMETHING SPECIAL IN JULY 2010!

Join 1,000 Scottish Guides and Senior Section at Netherurd, the Scottish Training & Activity Centre in Peeblesshire for the Scottish Centenary Camp. Come with your unit or a group from your District, Division or County or come on your own and make lots of new friends. No camping experience necessary. There will be indoor accommodation if you cannot sleep in a tent and a dedicated team of trained Guiders to provide support for anyone with additional needs.

There will be a special sub camp for Senior Section and 20 sub camps for Guides each named after an international mountain. The Senior Section sub camp will be staffed by experienced Guiders with the relevant camp and first aid qualifications. Your own Guider doesn't need a camp licence to bring you to this camp. The Senior Section sub camp is for girls aged 14 - 18. You must be aged 14 or over and registered as a senior section member by 17th July 2010. If you will be 18 by the start of camp you can either apply for the Senior Section sub camp (and take part in some activities) or apply as camp staff by completing a Guider application form.

The **COST** is £150 which includes site fees, food, some activities, camp t-shirt and badge and transport from a designated point in your County. A **non returnable deposit** of £50 must be paid with the application form. The **balance of £100 must be paid by 31st March 2010**. Cheques should be made payable to "Girlguiding Scotland".

The Senior Section will play an important role in supporting the smooth running of the camp. You will have a rota of allocated jobs at camp including helping run activities, media reporting, serving in the shop, helping in the office or with the crèche, be a "buddy" for a girl with additional needs, help the central catering team, site security and of course, cleaning the toilets (everyone's favourite job!) It will be hard work at times and you need to be prepared to do almost anything but it will be a lot of fun and very rewarding. In addition you will have the opportunity to take part in some of the exciting and varied activities open to the Guides - choose from Adventurous Activities, Creativity and Performing Arts, Traditional Camp Activities, Community Action, Global Development Village; enjoy fun and friendship at the camp fire, disco and ceilidh and a fun day out. There will also be some special activities just for the Senior Section and plenty of time to relax with your friends.
